

The Metropolitan PHILIP Educational Scholarship Fund

This is a newly formed fund, established by the Balamand Educational Foundation, to assist deserving students and especially those in need. It carries the name of Metropolitan PHILIP to honor his long-standing commitment and support of the University. Scholarships will be awarded to students who will be attending Balamand University. Students will be evaluated and approved by an independent board of directors.

The University of Balamand is a private, non-profit, independent Lebanese institution of higher learning. It performs its mission through teaching, research and service to the community. The University is committed to raising future generations in the immutable eastern values and does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, gender, nationality or physical handicap.

The University of Balamand was founded in El-Koura, Lebanon in 1988 by his Beatitude the Antiochian Orthodox Christian Patriarch Ignatius IV. It currently has nine schools, including the School of Medicine, Engineering Schools (civil, electric, mechanical, computer), Business School, the Academy of Fine Arts, St. John of Damascus Institute of Theology, Arts and Social Sciences, Hotel Management, Health Sciences (nursing, medical lab and technology), School of Science (computer science, physics and chemistry).

The University is located on the beautiful hill of the Balamand in North Lebanon and has a second campus in the capital, Beirut. The University has approximately 3,400 students who have carried the mission of the University in the Middle East and throughout the world. The University teaches in three languages, Arabic, English and French, but emphasizes English as the prevailing universal language, especially in Science and Technology.
